## **Alpha Table Host**

Being an Alpha Table Leader is similar to welcoming someone into your home. You host a meal (already prepared by our Chef) and facilitate a conversation where people can ask their questions about life, faith and God after watching a video. You don't have to provide answers, you simply have to offer hospitality. Training and support are provided.

*When: One evening or noon-hour a week during a specified term (normally twice a year for 2-3 months)*

## **Alpha Helper**

This position involves leading behind the scenes, supporting the Table Leader and assisting in facilitating conversations.

*When: One evening or noon-hour a week during a specified term (normally twice a year for 2-3 months)*

*Time Commitment: 1.5-3 hours per week*

## **ESL Café Table Host/Support**

Arrive 15 minutes early. Help to facilitate casual conversation according to themes, current events and more, and make others feel comfortable. These roles involve an application process, training and lesson plans.

*When: Monday evenings from 7 – 8:30 p.m. during the academic year*

*Where: St. Paul's*

*Time Commitment: 1.5 hours weekly*

## **Regent Park Community Dinner Volunteer**

Several times a year we partner with Church in the City to offer a hot meal on a Saturday evening to about 400 people in Regent Park. Come on your own or with your family (ages 9+) to help prepare then serve a meal or dessert and drinks.

*When: Saturday evenings, once every few months*

*Where: 40 Oak St.*

*Time Commitment: 2-3 hours*

## **Money Course Leader**

Teach the Christians Against Poverty money course. St. Paul's offers this course about three times a year, over three sessions.

*When: Once a week for three weeks*

*Where: St. Paul's*

*Time Commitment: 10 hours total*

## **Archives**

Preserving the historical records of our 176 year-old church is key. This opportunity is team-oriented. A background in library or archival science would be an asset.

*When: Daytime during the week*
