

## **HOSPITALITY**

### **Greeter/Usher**

Arrive 20-30 minutes early and provide a warm welcome to everyone attending the service. Smile, say hello, greet others, hand out bulletins and help people find seating. Be available to bring families to Children's Ministry or Youth Group. Additionally, this role involves collecting the offertory mid-service and, for the 11 a.m. service, ushering during Communion.

*When: before and during our 8:15, 9:30 and 11 a.m. services*

*Where: Atrium and Sanctuary*

*Time Commitment: 30 minutes for greeting, then 5-10 minutes later to collect the offertory. The 11 a.m. service includes a 10-15 minute time commitment to usher during communion.*

### **Greeter Coordinator**

Arrive 20 minutes early to support and lead all Greeters. Duties include checking in with the volunteers in your ministry, assigning them strategically near doors or within the Sanctuary, and making sure they have all they need to offer the best welcoming experience to everyone who comes to church. Additionally, this role involves regular greeting duties throughout the first half of the service, coordinating Greeters in collection and counting the congregation mid-service.

This role requires experience as a Greeter.

*When: before and during the 9:30 a.m. service*

*Where: Sanctuary*

*Time Commitment: 45-50 minutes*

### **St. Paul's Central**

Act as Host, primarily to newcomers and visitors at our welcome desk. Provide warmth, welcome, and answer any questions for those walking out of the service or coming in for the next one. Point out appropriate publications, receive Connection Cards, and connect new people with other church members and ministry leads. This position is needed for approximately 20 minutes.

*When: immediately following the 9:30 and 11 a.m. Sunday services*

*Where: Atrium*

*Time Commitment: 20 minutes*

### **Small Group Host**

Act as host for a small group, either making arrangements to meet at a pub or restaurant or in your own home.

*When: weekly or bi-weekly, various days of the week*

*Where: Host's home, St. Paul's, pub, or restaurant*

*Time Commitment: 2-3 hours per meeting*

### **Coffee/Tea Ministry**

Smile, chat, pour cups of coffee or tea and offer people cookies.

*When: immediately following the 11 am. Sunday service*

*Where: Atrium*

*Time Commitment: 20-30 minutes*

### **Cookie Ministry**

Bring in homemade or store-bought cookies and drop them off in a designated area. They will then be offered during coffee hour after the service.

*When: before the 9:30 and 11 a.m. services*

*Where: Atrium or Great Hall*

*Time Commitment: however long it takes you to bake cookies or buy them!*
