Free Concert Featuring the St. Paul's Bloor Street Choir



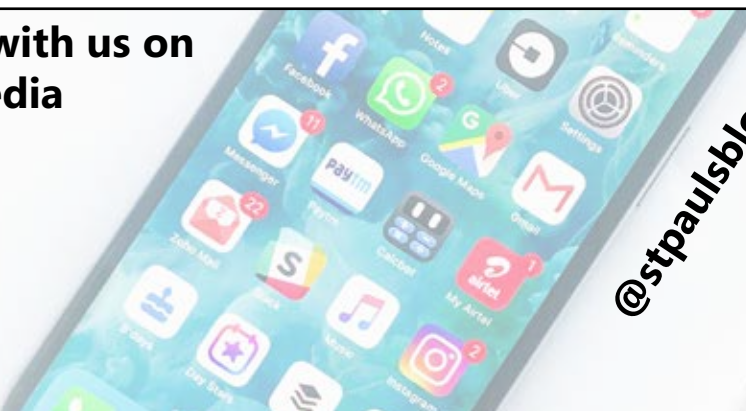
