

Pausing Through Art During Lent



For the 40 days leading up to Easter, two art installations are available that invite us to slow down and reflect. In the East Transept of the Sanctuary, we are invited to visit a constructed space that greets us with a reflective Bible passage, then welcomes us to experience two abstract paintings. You are encouraged to read the words, then allow your eyes to wander across the paintings, being aware of the space within you.



The second installation, across from Cody Hall, is a small exhibition of paintings. Engage your emotional response to the images. Spend time with them, making note of how response to the paintings might change, and try having a conversation with someone next to you about what they are experiencing. The act of viewing while examining oneself can be a powerful way through which God can reveal Himself to us and/or reveal ourselves to ourselves.

The installations will be available for viewing between and following services up until Good Friday (**April 20**). On **Sunday, April 7**, join us in the East Transept for a short artists' talk following each service. We pray you are blessed by these works this season. - *Ruthia Pak Regis and Matt G. Wood*
