1. What do you think when people say that life is not going back to the way it was, once we emerge from the pandemic?
2. Read Nehemiah 2: 1-3 Why was Nehemiah so afraid to share his grief with the King? Why do you think the King responded the way he did? What do you think of the idea that inside all our grief, a wish is buried?
3. Nehemiah spent months in prayer, before he took action to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem? What do you think is the connection between prayer and action? How might God be calling you to collaborate with others in the rebuilding of our lives and neighborhoods?
4. Nehemiah immediately faced resistance. How did he respond and how might that encourage you?
5. In what ways did Jenny say that Nehemiah points us to Jesus? How could that strengthen you for the future?
